



COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT



The Alabama Farm Center at Hallmark Farm is a sustainable investment in the state's future, thanks to a governance structure that provides for long-term financial support.

Site plans call for over 85 acres of commercial real estate development. The enabling legislation directs tax revenue from these tracts to benefit the operation and maintenance of the Alabama Farm Center.

North Jefferson County is one of Alabama's growth areas, with over 1,500 new homes planned in Warrior over the next 24 months. Major retailers and hotel chains have expressed interest the Alabama Farm Center site.

Development of the commercial tracts will provide food and overnight accommodations for Alabama Farm Center visitors while generating income for perpetual upkeep and improvement of event spaces.


